

## **Dining Server / Kitchen Steward Job Description:**

**Job Title:** Dining Server / Kitchen Steward

**Department:** Kitchen

**Reports To:** Head Chef

**Position is Seasonal from:** June 1st through October 9<sup>th</sup>. Priority given to applicants who can commit to the full season.

**Responsibilities:** *include but are not limited to:*

This position includes rotational shifts split between the Dining Room as Server and in the Kitchen as Steward. A 5-day work week will include 3-4 days in the dining room (breakfast, lunch and dinner) and 1-2 days as kitchen steward.

- Setting up and cleaning up buffets and tables for meals, cleaning up dining room after meals
- Transporting food and serving at BBQ's
- Taking meal orders at breakfast
- Serving food and beverages
- Assisting with food / beverage preparations and presentations
- Dishwashing, inventorying supplies, stocking supplies, unloading deliveries
- Maintaining a clean and a safe work area

Dining staff work 5-days a week with 2-days off. Work day includes periodic breaks between meals. Days off may vary from employee to employee to fit the ranch schedule.

### **Requirements:**

- The physical ability to do the job; lifting, climbing, stooping, kneeling, reaching and more.
- Work experience in the food industry preferred
- Valid driver's license and clean driving record

- Must be energetic, intelligent, out-going, responsible, conversational, trustworthy, compassionate
- Ability to be flexible about the work schedule and the job duties and be willing to do “what it takes” to get the Ranch work done.

### **Dress Code:**

All Crew members are expected to maintain a clean and tidy appearance, fitting of ranch life and job duty and adhering to the Ranch's western culture.

- Nonslip shoes (no open-toed shoes)
- When serving most meals western-style (*encouraged*), neat, clean but casual outfits are required, *no shorts for any dinner service*
- At our three “sit-down dinners” as well as on Sunday nights (welcome dinner) servers are asked to dress a little more nicely (*no t-shirts*)
- Aprons and gloves will be provided for dishwashing

### **Compensation:**

Room & Board, Salary & Gratuities

Gratuities (received during 16-week guest-season) are generous with opportunity to earn more by participating in extra activities with guests. *For reference, gratuities in 2025 averaged ~\$8,000 for the season, but please note gratuity amounts will fluctuate year to year and amounts are not guaranteed.*
